Nye County is the largest county by area in the state of Nevada and the third largest county in the contiguous United States. It offers a country-like atmosphere for an easy-flowing lifestyle.

Tonopah is the county seat and is a perfect place to enjoy the many outdoor recreational activities such as hiking, mountain biking, off-roading and hunting.

The Town of Pahrump is an unincorporated town and the population center of Nye County, located at the southernmost tip of the County, approximately 60 miles west of Las Vegas. Pahrump is home of several wineries, outdoor activities, and Spring Mountain Speedway. It is one of the fastest growing towns in Nevada.
